History of the Ethereum Classic Cooperative



When Bob Summerwill joined the ETC Cooperative as its first Executive Director on 28th January 2019, there were no canonical **public** records.

There were good private records in the Dropbox which Anthony Lusardi had set up, but there was no single canonical timeline joining together those together into a cohesive narrative. That document seeks to fill that purpose.

ETC Cooperative - Q3 2017

The Ethereum Classic Cooperative Inc was incorporated in the State of Delaware as an LLC (Limited Liability Corporation) on 7th September 2017, with <u>Barry Silbert</u> as the sole Director, and with the stated intention of conversion to a non-profit entity subject to IRS approval.

Barry Silbert is Founder and CEO of both <u>DCG</u> (parent company) and <u>Grayscale</u>. The ETC Cooperative was "birthed" by Grayscale.

ETC Cooperative was announced at <u>ETC Summit 2017</u>, which was held in Hong Kong on 13th and 14th November 2017 by Michael Sonnenshein of Grayscale in "Introducing the Ethereum Classic Cooperative". I am searching for slides and video.

Effective immediately, the fund's spending policy is being implemented to meet several objectives:

- Directly support the development of the Ethereum Classic protocol, infrastructure, and associated applications.
- Accelerate the deployment of Ethereum Classic-based technologies for use by individuals, business operators, and enterprises through effective branding, marketing, and education.
- Foster community and collaboration between the various Ethereum Classic constituents including developers, miners, investors, and business operators.

ETC's monetary policy hard fork (<u>ECIP-1017</u> and <u>ECIP-1039</u>) went live at block 5,000,000, on December 11th 2017.

The first funds transfer from Grayscale to the ETC Cooperative was made at the end of Q4 2017 retroactively covering the fees for the previous three quarters, for a total payment of \$371,505 USD.

An Advisory Council was <u>announced in 1st March 2018</u>, compromising <u>Barry Silbert</u> (Founder and CEO, DCG), <u>James Wo</u> (Founder and CEO, DFG, Founder and Chairman, ETC Labs), <u>Igor Artamonov</u> (Founder, ETCDEV), <u>Elaine Ou</u> (Global Financial Access) and <u>Charles Hoskinson</u> (CEO, IOHK).

The second funds transfer from Grayscale occurred at the end of Q1 2018, for \$247,000, giving Anthony a warchest of over \$600K at the start of his tenure.

Ethereum Classic Cooperative Inc was converted from an LLC to a non-stock corporation on 4th May 2018:

The Organization Meeting of the Cooperative was held on 10th May 2018, with the Certificate of Incorporation, Bylaws and Board of Directors confirmed in that meeting. The initial directors were Barry Silbert (Founder and CEO, DCG), James Wo (Founder and CEO, DFG, Founder and Chairman, ETC Labs) and Cody Burns, all of whom are still in those roles at the time of writing.

On 14th May 2018 the Cooperative received a <u>donation of \$250,000 USD</u> from DFG. The third funds transfer from Grayscale occurred at the end of Q2 2018, for \$158,000 USD.

On 15th May 2018 there was an <u>announcement of Anthony Lusardi and Christian Xu's roles</u> within the ETC Cooperative, as Director, US and Community Manager, China, respectively.

The status of the Advisory Council from this point is unclear. Barry and James, who were part of the Advisory Council, had now joined the Board of Directors, so presumably the Advisory Council was down to Elaine Ou, Charles Hoskinson and Igor Artamonov by May 2018. I am unsure if the Council ever met. TODO - Ask James and Barry.

Bylaws of the Ethereum Classic Cooperative at incorporation

- Between 3 and 15 Directors
- Officers Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer
- AGM each February. Officers re-elected each year at AGM.
- Officer or employees may be removed from their roles by a majority vote of the BOD.
 Board actions and resolutions may be taken by Directors without meeting in-person (email, DocuSign, conference calls, etc)
- Board of Directors may appoint Advisors.
- There is a Conflict of Interest Policy. Non Discrimination Policy.
 No Whistleblower Policy. Anything else which is best practice?
- Who is Chairperson? Who is Vice-Chairperson? None appointed, it seems.
- Samantha McDonald as Treasurer. When was Anthony appointed? There are no other named officers.

The difficulty bomb was disabled (<u>ECIP-1041</u>) with a hard-fork activated at block 5,900,000, on 29th May 2018.

ETC Summit 2018 was held in Seoul, South Korea, on September 12th and 13th.

The fourth funds transfer from Grayscale occurred at the end of Q3 2018, for \$165,000 USD.

<u>Yaz Khoury was hired</u> as Director, Developer Operations, USA, on 15th October 2018, with his contract due to expire on 18th October 2019, at a rate of \$9200 USD per month.

Virgil Griffith of the Ethereum Foundation <u>announced a donation of 15K ETC</u> on 30th October 2018. That is now worth ~\$70K USD marked-to-market.

The Cooperative was approved for conversion to a 501(c)(3) public charity by the IRS on 14th November 2018, with the effective date of exemption being retroactive to 10th May 2018. Charitable donations to the Cooperative are tax deductible under IRC Section 170.

<u>Bob Summerwill</u> and ETC Cooperative signed an Independent Contractor agreement which saw him <u>starting work as the Executive Director of the ETC Cooperative</u> on Monday 28th January 2019, with initial compensation of \$175K per annum, raising to \$200K per annum starting 1st January 2020, and with no fixed end-date.

Anthony Lusardi <u>resigned from the Coop</u> on 18th March 2019 and on 20th March 2019 by resolution of the Board of Directors, <u>Bob Summerwill</u> replaced <u>Anthony Lusardi</u> as Secretary and <u>Simcha Wurtzel</u> (VP Finance and Controller, DCG) replaced Samanta McDonald who has left DCG since May 2018.

"So why leave? In short I simply cannot deal anymore. My role was highly visible and largely required me to respond and deal with a lot of social media. If something bad happened, people would spread FUD and I'd have to respond. If something good happened, same thing. It felt as if no news was the only good news I'd actually get." - Anthony Lusardi

ETC Summit 2019 was held in Vancouver, Canada, on October 3rd and October 4th and was a huge success, with 550+ tickets reserved and around 300 peak attendees. <u>Live Streams</u> and <u>Individual Talks</u> are being uploaded to YouTube piecemeal.

In the opening address on Day 2 of the Summit, Bob Summerwill was <u>delighted to announce</u> the archiving of https://github.com/ethereumproject and a cease-fire in the Repo Wars. This was a huge achievement for the ecosystem and the result of many months of discussion with ETC Labs.
